



-- Attention Campers -- What to Bring to Handi-Camp

Clothing -- A sufficient supply for the entire Handi-Camp. That includes underwear, clothing for each day, shoes & socks, clothes to sleep in, jacket, hat, swim suit (for camps where swimming is included),

Bedding/Personal Care -- Sheets, pillows, blankets, towels, soap, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, sunscreen, insect repellent, & other personal care items.

And -- If required...a sufficient supply of "Depends" (adult under-garments), Feminine, or other, personal hygiene products **for the entire session**.

Bible (if the camper has one).

Most Important -- **Medications** - Whether prescription or non-prescription, all meds must be in original pharmacy or pharmaceutical company labeled containers with clear/up-to-date instructions.

PLEASE NOTE -- Neither the camp nor Power Ministries are responsible for providing needed supplies for the camper. If adequate supplies have not been packed, it will be necessary to contact you to have those supplies delivered promptly.

And...What Not to Bring to Handi-Camp

Tobacco products of any kind, or any device or product that produces (non-medicinal) smoke or vapor intended for lung inhalation, alcoholic beverages of any kind, controlled substances/illegal drugs.

Firearms or archery devices of any kind, knives, multi-tools, scissors or other cutting devices

Mobile phones (unless mutually determined as required), electronic games, mp3/CD players and/or other devices requiring headphones

Prank Items, matches, lighters or fireworks of any kind

Clothing that would be regarded as inappropriate in a Christian Camp setting

Clothing (t-shirts, sweatshirts, etc.) that contains any message or graphic, other than a Christian theme
